

# \*\*\*FINANCE MINUTES\*\*\*

April 6, 2016

## SAUKVILLE MUNICIPAL CENTER 639 E. GREEN BAY AVE., SAUKVILLE, WI 53080

Village President Barb Dickmann called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Village Clerk Mary Kay Baumann gave the Statement of Public Notice.

Members: Barb Dickmann-present, David Maglio-present, Dan Sauer-present, Mike Krocka-present, Michael Gielow-present, Joe Caban-present, and Scott Fischer-present.

Others Present: Dawn Wagner, Mary Kay Baumann, Chief Goetz, Ray Hartmann, Dale Kropidlowski, Ray deBruijn, and Mark Jaeger.

### WATER SYSTEM FLUORIDATION

Kropidlowski stated that the Village is in the design phase of the Well #6 development. Staff felt that this was an appropriate time to decide whether or not to continue fluoridation as it will make a difference in the design of the building.

Utility staff has requested that fluoridation be removed from the system.

Sauer stated that Utility staff did a great job researching the area. It was determined that most communities do not fluoridate. The EPA recommendation is .6 and .5 occurs naturally. That is only .1 from the standard.

Dickmann asked if there was any reason to keep it in. Kropidlowski stated that it seems like a lot of work for the small amount.

Kropidlowski stated that the current supply should take the Village through August 1<sup>st</sup>.

Sauer/Fischer made a motion to recommend to the Village Board discontinuing fluoridation of the Village's water once the current supply is depleted, estimated to be August 1<sup>st</sup>. Motion carried.

### OTHER MATTERS

Baumann provided results from the April 5<sup>th</sup> Spring Election.

Wagner stated that the Village is hosting joint training on Thursday, April 14<sup>th</sup>. The topic will be "Attitude Makes a Difference".

Wagner reminded everyone that Ozaukee Economic Development will be holding their Annual Outreach on April 26<sup>th</sup>.

Maglio/Krocka made a motion to adjourn. Motion carried at 7:40 p.m.
