Call to Order

- Maglio called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Statement of Public Notice

- Wagner gave the statement of Public Notice.

POLICE REPORT – Chief Meyer and Lieutenant Kosmosky

- The department had 7,853 calls for service in 2019 – up 1,364 from 2018
- Hired Officers Cameron Deppiese and Amani Anjum. Both have completed the field training program and are on solo patrol.
- 292 criminal arrests made with 34 of those being felony in 2019.
- Revenue from Mid Moraine Municipal Court through November 2019 \$10,925, up 27.15% from 2018.
- Shop with a Cop was another huge success. Camping World and Marcus Cinema joined as community partners this year.
- New body cams and squad video being purchased, joint camera system capabilities.
- New load bearing vests for officers, working out very well and the officers love them.
- Working on a switch from Explorers to Tahoe for squads.
- Drone purchased and training in the works for 5 pilots.
- Northwestern School of Police Staff and Command – March 16 – May 22

FIRE/EMS REPORT – Chief Trinko

- Chief reported he has been on the job for 30 days so far and is working on getting to know the organization, staff and who is in charge of what, going through paperwork and documentation
- Looking at different reporting systems to put in place and make sure our technology can handle any new systems

- Responded to many fires throughout the community and working on building relationships with county chiefs and other department personnel
- Conducting an inventory of all equipment, what is working and not working, what needs to be replaced for safety reasons.
- Working on getting the computers hooked up to the Village networking system.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT REPORT – EM Director Sara deBruijn

- Continuing to work with the county on mitigating and controlling past and future flooding incidents.
- Working on getting maintenance done on the river gauge box.
- Training season is in full swing so taking advantage of the classes being provided by the state and county that are offered at no cost to the Village.

Other Matters

- Meeting will take place every other month from now on with March being the next meeting.
