Cemetery Grading/Landscape Project

Helm stated the project was completed by Mile Rock in November 2022. Public Works top-dressed and seeded the area for grass in Spring of 2023.

Helm has obtained the CDL Training certification and will be able to train the Village Staff directly. The CDL requirements have changed and requires an individual to attend 2 months of classes with a cost of \$4200.00.

Helm and Wagner had a meeting with UW-Milwaukee community design solutions department regarding the possibility of working with them on a capstone project, free of cost for a DPW building study for future expansion.
