**WATER SYSTEM UPDATES**

Kropidowski reviewed the progress on the Pilot Study being conducted at Well #5 for iron removal.

Kropidowski stated that the results from the study were good. A full report with recommendations should be completed in approximately 2 weeks.

Kropidowski reported that Ruckert & Mielke has completed the water study and a draft has been forwarded to the Village for review. Staff provided comments to R & M for consideration.

Work on painting the water tower on Dekora Woods Blvd is scheduled to begin the week of May 23<sup>rd</sup>. The project should take about 1 month. Kropidowski stated that funding for the project is from the 2021 Borrowing.

**WASTEWATER SYSTEM UPDATES**

Hartmann gave an overview of the progress on the WWTP project.

- Filter Building - the hole has been dug and pipe installation in the ground.
- Bypass is complete - gravity flow vs. pumping
- Iron workers are on site this week (5-15-22)
- In the process of choosing floor color
- JT Roofing has begun work on the Administration Bldg, work on the Secondary Bldg and Sludge Bldg will be completed next
- The SCADA update is scheduled to start soon
- CWFL Loan closing is scheduled for June 8, 2022
- ARPA money for 2022 - \$8,000 remains from the \$50,000
- Slip lining of sewers on Chiswell and Mill Streets has been completed.

**WWTP PROJECT TOUR**

The Utility Committee toured the filter building as part of the plant upgrade.

**OTHER MATTERS**

Hartmann stated that Spectrum and Digi-Corp have completed the internet and phone security updates.

**ADJOURNMENT**

Fischer/Janus made a motion to adjourn. Motion carried at 6:05 p.m.
