

## Public Works Minutes

June 21, 2022

Public Works Chairperson Trevor Seitz called the meeting to Order at 5:01 p.m.

Village Administrator Dawn Wagner gave the Statement of Public Notice

### **2022 Project/Equipment Update**

Helm reported on the 2022 Project/Equipment Update.

- The DPW salt shed and pole barn was installed by JK contractors. (\$2,700 under budget)
- The gutters were replaced on the West side of the firehouse.
- Shoulder work was completed on Klein and Technology.
- Showalter concession gutters/roof/siding was completed with DPW painting the building.
- Numerous areas of sidewalk are being removed and replaced by DPW staff. (concentrating on areas within the 4<sup>th</sup> of July festivities)
- Struck & Irwin is slurry sealing a section of Dekora Woods that is starting to break apart and gator. (Fransee Ln was supposed to get done but a bunch of utility work came up and the road has to be patched in areas)
- Firehouse parking lot and the driveway at Quade park are scheduled to get sealed and stripped by NR asphalt in early August.
- Fence work at Grady Park was completed.
- DPW staff will be working on landscaping improvements at PD/Village hall in July. (concentrating on the islands/bed areas)
- DPW staff will be rebuilding 3 manholes on Mill St that are failing and need to be leveled to the existing road
- Street Sweep Repair total of \$8,440.79.
- Fuel Cost is at 60% of the budget YTD.

### **Bandstand Project Update**

Helm reported on the 2022 Bandstand Project Update

- With the cold and rainy Spring Holton Brothers were not able to complete the work in time for the Memorial Day celebration and the start of the Live at Triangle concerts. I pushed the project to September when all the concerts are done with.
- After discussion with Holton Brothers we decided that before any concerts start that we secure all the areas that are in most need of work.

- The railings were roded with rebar to hold them in place.
- The railing caps were also roded and epoxied because they were loose.
- Several other areas on the top decking were mordered in place.
- Holton Brothers said they were comfortable that it would be safe for the upcoming concerts and the rest of the repair can wait until September.

### **Chiswell Street Project (Colonial Parkway – Regis Rd)**

Helm reported on the Chiswell Street Project

- The section of Chiswell between Colonial and Regis is completely failing and in need of repair. Besides the extreme cracking and constant potholes, it is about 2 inches below curb line grade in certain areas and water/ice just sit in those areas.
- Payne & Dolan was the lowest bid at \$ 31,925.00.
- They will mill 4" of existing asphalt and construct and grade in a new base underneath the asphalt.
- The project is only projected to take 2 days.

### **Other Matters**

- The (2) summer help positions were filled by Eli Perez and Brady Fleishmann. (They have been here for 2 weeks)
- Railroad Company made repairs to both the 33 Crossing and the Cold Spring Crossing.
- Ozaukee County crack filled Mill St.
- The new Jersey barricades arrived and are staged on S Park St.
- We had multiple areas with tree damage from the windstorm on Wednesday, June 15<sup>th</sup>. There was a tree down completely blocking Mill St. Public Works was called in at 9:00 p.m. and was completely clean up by 10:36 p.m.
