Salary & Benefits: Starting salary of \$62,020 to \$81,642 after just 4 years. Paid vacation; 11 paid holidays; sick leave; health/life/disability insurance; Wisconsin retirement system; deferred compensation; longevity pay; workout room.

Lateral Transfer Program: New employees may be granted wages, vacation time, and health insurance premiums proportional to years of continuous service for another law enforcement agency. These benefits will be considered on a case by case basis and at the sole discretion of the Chief of Police.
